About OK Grow

OK Grow is a new food growing project to grow vegetables for Walworth Community Food Hub.

We have a 2000m² site on Albany Rd in SE17 and will start gardening this April. The aims of the project are to engage as many people as possible in growing food and to see how much food it's possible to grow in our first year.

About the Job

You would be responsible for running two volunteering sessions a week, on Thursday and Saturday afternoons, and would work with the project co-ordinator to plan how the space will be planted and maintained through the season to maximise production.

A good knowledge of food growing is essential. You must be able to multi-task, managing and working with volunteers whilst balancing this with the productive needs of the garden.
